Seat Pleasant Police Officers Capture Carjackers

Seat Pleasant, MD December 3, 2009: On December 2, 2009 Tennessee U.S. Senator Bob Corker's daughter was carjacked in China Town, Washington, DC. The suspects proceeded to Prince George's County. Later that evening, Prince George's County communications gave a broadcast for the carjacking that was being tracked by Onstar. The last known location was in the area of Central Avenue and Addison Road in Seat Pleasant, MD.

Seat Pleasant Police Officers Tracey Burnett, Jose Perez and Aaron Forester actively searched the area and located the vehicle in the Addison Plaza Shopping Center. The occupants were apprehended and transported to District III Criminal Investigation Division to be interviewed by Prince George's County and Washington DC Metropolitan Police detectives.

Mayor Eugene Grant stated, "I along with the Seat Pleasant City Council applaud the professional efforts of our fine police force." He went on to say, "I am proud of the fine men who make up our department and who are keenly dedicated to protecting and serving our City of Excellence."

Seat Pleasant: A City of Excellence is a small urban community situated east of the District of Columbia with a population of approximately 5,000 residents, 100 businesses, and 13 churches in Prince George's County, Maryland. The government is comprised of an elected mayor and seven councilmember's who serve a four year term. The City Administrator runs the daily operations of the City and oversees a budget of \$3 million dollars annually.
