Did you know that according to the March 2012 CDC Report Autism now affects 1 in 88 children? The number of Prince Georges County Public Schools students identified as Autistic has risen from 606 in the 2004-2005 school year to 1,139 in the 2011-2012 school year. Seat Pleasant Elementary School houses more children with Autism than any other school in the county, 60 students, and 15 more will enroll next school year.
