We do accept couches, appliances, grills, lawnmowers, tables, bikes, mattresses, and box springs (must be covered in mattress plastic), etc.

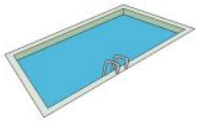
We do not accept construction materials (pvc pipes, drywall, tiles, etc.), propane or helium tanks, tires, items with nails, etc.
