My name is James Wright, Jr. and I am the new Seat Pleasant City Council member at-large. I was selected by the Seat Pleasant City Council on Monday, Oct. 10 to fill the vacancy of Council member Kelly Porter, who was picked to be the city's new mayor in June.

I have lived in Seat Pleasant since 2005 as a Ward 1 resident. Before coming to the city, I lived in Washington, D.C. in the Columbia Heights neighborhood. I am a native of Austin, Texas.

I work as a journalist for the Washington Informer Newspaper, the only and largest comprehensive weekly newspaper in Washington, D.C. The Informer is also a Black-female owned media company. I have also worked at The Washington Post, the Washington AFRO-American Newspaper and written numerous freelance articles for various publications, including the Los Angeles Times. My beat is local Washington, D.C. politics and writing business stories.

I attend Asbury United Methodist Church in Washington, D.C. where I serve as the church historian and a member of the United Methodist Men. Brotherhood is a dear thing to me as I am privileged to be a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Inc., in the Omicron Lambda Alpha chapter, serving as the Associate Editor to The Sphinx. Alpha has been a part of my life since Spring 1984.

I am a 1986 graduate of Prairie View A & M University in Texas with a bachelor's degree in business management and a concentration in communications.



In Seat Pleasant, I volunteer as the vice chairman of CPAC, a support organization for the city's police department. I am also a member of the Prince George's County branch of the NAACP.

On the council, I am the chairman of the Economic, Planning, Development & Housing committee. My committee memberships are Human Services, Health & Education chaired by

Ward 5 Council member Gloria Sistrunk and Governmental Affairs & Technology led by Ward 4 Council member Gerald Raynor, Sr.

My priorities on the council include facilitating constituent services, increasing Latino involvement in local governmental and civic affairs and tackling senior hunger.





ADVANCED VR TRAINING FOR SPPD OFFICERS

In 2022, the police department began using new technology to provide officers with advanced training. The Apex Officer training simulator is a state-of-the-art tool that utilizes virtual reality technology and offers an immersive 360-degree view and includes peripheral vision and training tools that closely match those used in the field to enhance the transferability of the training to real-life scenarios.

The simulator allows for scenarios to be customized by a certified trainer based on the officer's decisions and assists the officer in evaluating how they would make decisions.

- PARK IN WELL-LIT AREAS IF SHOPPING IN THE EVENING.
- BE AWARE OF YOUR SURROUNDINGS.
- WATCH OUT FOR CREDIT/DEBIT CARD SKIMMERS. A SKIMMER IS A DEVICE INSTALLED ON CARD READERS THAT COLLECTS CARD NUMBERS. THIEVES WILL LATER RECOVER AND USE THIS INFORMATION TO MAKE FRAUDULENT PURCHASES. SKIMMERS CAN USUALLY BE SPOTTED BY DOING QUICK VISUAL OR PHYSICAL INSPECTIONS BEFORE SWIPING OR INSERTING A CARD.
