AN ORDINANCE EMERGENCY ORDINANCE concerning

**AMENDMENT OF THE
FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009 BUDGET
FOR THE CITY OF SEAT PLEASANT, MARYLAND**

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SEAT PLEASANT CITY COUNCIL that the 2008-2009 Budget of the City of Seat Pleasant shall be amended as follows:

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE SEAT PLEASANT CITY COUNCIL that an emergency exists that affects life, health, property or the public peace requiring immediate action. The emergency is that delays that would be occasioned by proceeding with this Ordinance as a regular ordinance effective in twenty (20) days after approval by the Mayor or approval of the City Council over the veto of the Mayor would result in the inability of the City to provide funds to the Seat Pleasant Community Development Corporation, and may result in the loss of nearly \$200,000 Community Legacy funds to the City, for use for the

Project described in Resolution No. 09-13 adopted by the City Council on March 26, 2009, such Project being for the acquisition and rehabilitation of a property that poses a threat to the public health, safety and welfare.


SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE SEAT PLEASANT CITY COUNCIL that it is the intent of the City Council that the appropriation of the amount of \$200,000 from Fund Balance, Account No. 3305.00, to Account No. 4372.00 as set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be reimbursed to Fund Balance, Account No. 3305.00, promptly after receipt of Community Legacy Program loan funds by the City from the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development ("DHCD") pursuant to Community Legacy Program Agreements between the City of Seat Pleasant and the Department of Housing and Community Development dated June 29, 2006 and June 7, 2007; and that the appropriation of \$200,000 from Fund Balance, Account No. 3305.00, to Account No. 4372.00 shall be for the purpose of authorizing the expenditure of City funds, prior to reimbursement from Community Legacy Program loan funds to be received by the City from DHCD, for the Project to be undertaken by the Seat Pleasant Community Development Corporation pursuant to a Community Legacy Funds Agreement dated March 26, 2009 between the City of Seat Pleasant and the Seat Pleasant Community Development Corporation.

SECTION 2 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE SEAT PLEASANT CITY COUNCIL that, having been approved by the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3rds) of the entire City Council, that the City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance, and cause the same to be published as required by law; and that this Ordinance shall become effective ~~twenty (20) days following~~ immediately upon approval by the Mayor or passage by the Council after the veto by the Mayor.
