ORDINANCE 93- 01

INTRODUCED BY: City Council

ENACTED : June 7, 1993

AN ORDINANCE to Adopt the Budget for Fiscal Year 1993-94.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Mayor and City Council of Seat Pleasant, Maryland, that the sums and amounts appropriated for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 1993 and ending June 30, 1994.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED that the following sums and amounts are hereby appropriated for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 1993 and ending June 30, 1994 to defray expenses and operations for the City of Seat Pleasant:

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED that the Real Property Tax for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 1993 and ending June 30, 1994, shall be at a rate of one dollar (1.00) per one hundred dollars (100.00) of assessed real property value.


SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED AND ENACTED that the Business Licenses for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 1993 and ending June 30, 1994 shall be at the following rates:


