ENACTED : July 12, 1993

A RESOLUTION to vigorously oppose a Class D Beer and Wine License for use of Peoples Food, Inc, Inc. (IGS) 401 Eastern Avenue.

WHEREAS, it was the general consensus of the City Council to oppose the sale of alcoholic beverages as requested by the applicant; and

WHEREAS, the granting of such a beer license is opposed by a substantial number of citizens in the City of Seat Pleasant; and


WHEREAS, the granting of a beer license contiguous to a predominated residential area in the City would have adverse impact on the existing residential character of the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the granting of an additional beer license in a community already adequately served by at least four other beer licensed facilities within a mile from 401 Eastern Avenue is unnecessary.


