A RESOLUTION to

ENDORSE AND SUPPORT THE INTRODUCTION AND APPROVAL OF A BOND BILL IN THE 2010 SESSION OF THE MARYLAND GENERAL ASSEMBLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING \$250,000 MATCHING FUNDS TO THE CITY OF SEAT PLEASANT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, REPAIR, RENOVATION, RECONSTRUCTION AND CAPITAL EQUIPPING OF THE JOHN E. FEGGANS CENTER IN THE CITY OF SEAT PLEASANT.

WHEREAS, the John E. Feggans Center, formerly known as the Greendale Center, (“the Center”) in the City of Seat Pleasant (“the City”) has long been a hub of gathering and community social and recreational activities for residents of the City and surrounding areas, and a location for offices for City government and non-profit organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Center is in a significant state of disrepair and obsolescence and not fit for human occupancy, thus depriving the City and its residents of an essential municipal asset; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City desire to construct, repair, renovate, reconstruct, and acquire capital equipment for, the Center; and

WHEREAS, the City, through its elected State representatives, has requested the Maryland General Assembly to initiate and pass a “bond bill” in the 2010 Session of the General Assembly to provide the City with matching funding from the State of Maryland to assist the City in paying for the construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction and capital equipping of the Center; and

WHEREAS, Senator Nathaniel Exum has agreed to introduce legislation in the Maryland Senate for a bond bill to provide the City of Seat Pleasant with matching State funding in the amount of \$250,000 for such purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Legislative Services has designated Senator Exum's request for this bond bill for the City as lr1236; and

WHEREAS, by this Resolution the Seat Pleasant City Council desires to endorse and show support for the bond bill initiated by Senator Exum to provide the City with \$250,000 in matching State funds to assist the City in paying for the construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction and capital equipping of the Center; and

WHEREAS, by his signature on this Resolution the Mayor of Seat Pleasant also shows his endorsement and support for the bond bill initiated by Senator Exum.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SEAT PLEASANT CITY COUNCIL, that the City Council hereby endorses and supports the bond bill initiated by Senator Nathaniel Exum in the 2010 Session of the Maryland General Assembly to provide the City of Seat Pleasant with \$250,000 in matching State funds to assist the City in paying for the construction, repair, renovation, reconstruction and capital equipping of the John E. Feggans Center; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor of the City of Seat Pleasant be, and is hereby requested to endorse his signature on this Resolution, thereby indicating his approval thereof; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Council of Seat Pleasant and other City officials are hereby authorized to execute documents and take any action necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be sent to Senator Nathaniel Exum and other members of the Maryland General Assembly as appropriate.
