A RESOLUTION concerning


Waiver of Competitive Bidding – School Zone Speed Monitoring System

FOR the purpose of exempting from the City’s competitive bidding requirements a procurement relating to the implementation of a School Zone Speed Monitoring System enforcement program in the City of Seat Pleasant.


EXPLANATORY STATEMENT: The City desires to establish a School Zone Speed Monitoring System enforcement program. The City Administrator advertised for proposals for services for the implementation of this program but received no proposals in response to that solicitation. The City has determined that Optotrafic, a Division of Sigma Space Corporation, is the only vendor capable of supplying, installing and assisting the City to administer the School Zone Speed Monitoring System program. The purpose of this Resolution is to exempt this procurement from the competitive bidding requirements of Chapter 39 of the Code of the City of Seat Pleasant. Now, therefore,

SECTION I. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEAT PLEASANT, that, in accordance with Section 39-3.B. of the Code of The City of Seat Pleasant, the City Council finds that Optotrafic, a Division of Sigma Space Corporation, is the only vendor capable of supplying, installing and assisting the City to administer the City’s School Zone Speed Monitoring System program. Therefore, the City Council, acting by the affirmative vote of at least a majority of the whole Council, exempts this procurement from the City’s competitive bidding requirements and authorizes the City Administrator to consummate such transaction, subject to and to the extent of the availability of funds in the City’s budget for such purpose.
