A RESOLUTION concerning

**THE MARYLAND-NATIONAL CAPITAL PARK AND PLANNING COMMISSION
AND PARK AND RECREATION COUNCIL RELATIONSHIPS**

WHEREAS, the providing of leisure services to Prince George's County has been a joint effort among the municipal park and recreation departments, The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC), and volunteer groups organized into community park and recreation councils and the Prince George's County Federation of Park and Recreation Councils; and

WHEREAS, these park and recreation councils and their Federation serve as the principal bridge between the community, municipal park and recreation departments, and the M-NCPPC for local park and recreation requirements and programs; and

WHEREAS, this Park and Recreation Council concept has been a position force for more than 30 years in the delivery of leisure services to the citizens of Prince George's County by furnishing volunteer labor, equipment, supplies, and community involvement; and

WHEREAS, the park and recreation councils have benefited from professional staff making the partnership a cost-effective and proven advantage to both parties; and

WHEREAS, because of this joint effort upon the part of volunteer recreators, municipal and M-NCPPC staff, tax dollars have been saved and the citizens of Prince George's County have benefited. .

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the M-NCPPC officially recognizes the Park and Recreation Council concept as a basis for volunteer participation in park and recreation programs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SEAT PLEASANT CITY COUNCIL and the M-NCPPC officially recognizes the community park and recreation councils and their Federation, as a volunteer bridge between the citizens of Prince George's County; the

communities they represent; and the M-NCPPC Department of Parks and Recreation for park and recreation services requirement and programs..

SECTION I: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City of Seat Pleasant wishes to establish a Seat Pleasant Recreation Council;

SECTION II: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the objects of this Council shall be to develop a well-rounded park and recreation program for the community by rendering necessary aid to the M-NCPPC Park and Recreation Departments; to effect proper cooperation of all agencies and organizations in the community interested in leisure services so as to eliminate unnecessary duplication of effort


SECTION III: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Council shall be composed of one delegate for each agency or organization in the community interested in parks and recreation.

- A) Should the delegate not be able to attend a Council meeting, he shall notify the organization's chairman who shall select an alternate.
- B) Should any organization not be represented by a delegate for three consecutive meetings that fact alone shall be considered as a withdrawal from Council membership.
- C) The Secretary shall notify the President of an organization which has not been represented by an official delegate for two consecutive meetings of this fact


SECTION IV: BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT The Recreation Council shall officers in the following manner, President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer. The officers shall be elected at the annual meeting by its membership. The duties of the officers shall be as implied by their titles.
