Approval of Skidmore, Owings & Merrill, LLP



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEAT PLEASANT, that the City Administrator has executed the attached agreement after the adoption of Ordinance O-17-03 by the City Council and approval of Ordinance O-17-03 by the Mayor or passage by the Council after the veto by the Mayor.




