MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL CITY OF SEAT PLEASANT, MARYLAND RESOLUTION NUMBER 79-02

INTRODUCED: April 9, 1979

ENACTED:

A RESOLUTION requesting the Prince George's County Council to adopt the name of "Seat Pleasant" for the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority station.

WHEREAS, the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority station located at the intersection of Central Avenue and Addison Road is in the center of the area generally referred to as Seat Pleasant and borders the City of Seat Pleasant proper, and

WHEREAS, most other transit stations are named for the general area or jurisdiction in which they are located,

SECTION 1. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Seat Pleasant, Maryland that the Prince George's County Council be urged to adopt the name of Seat Pleasant for the transit station located on its border at the intersection of Central Avenue and Addison Road.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHUR RESOLVED AND ENACTED, that this resolution be and it is hereby enacted this <u>2nd</u> day of <u>April</u> 1979, to be effective immediately.
