
**Waiver of Competitive Bidding – Car Radio Acquisition**

**FOR** the purpose of exempting the purchase of in car radios for the use of the City Police Department from the City’s competitive bidding requirements.


**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:** The City of Seat Pleasant Police Department is in serious need of acquiring 12 in car radios to allow the Police Department to provide essential and satisfactory services to persons and property in the City of Seat Pleasant. The purpose of this Resolution is to exempt these acquisitions from the competitive bidding requirements of Chapter 39 of the Code of the City of Seat Pleasant. Now, therefore,

**SECTION I. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEAT PLEASANT,** that, in accordance with Section 39-3.A. of the Code of the City of Seat Pleasant, the City Council finds that the delays that now would be occasioned by proceeding with a formal competitive bid process as outlined in Chapter 39 of the City Code for the acquisition of 12 in car radios for the police vehicles for the City’s Police Department would be detrimental to the safety and welfare of the community. Therefore, the City Council, acting by the affirmative vote of at least a majority of the whole Council, exempts the acquisition of these in car radios from the City’s competitive bidding requirements and authorizes the City to consummate such transactions, subject to and to the extent of the availability of funds in the City’s budget for such purpose.
