A RESOLUTION concerning

**DESIGNATING THE CITY OF SEAT PLEASANT AS A SMART CITY
WITH AN INNOVATION VILLAGE AND APPROVING THE SMART
CITY PROJECT.**

WHEREAS, The City of Seat Pleasant (the “City”) is rebranding itself as a designated Smart City with an Innovative Village focusing on Transportation, Talents, and Technology by building on the City's current infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City’s Smart City project will include the expansion of City Hall to house an Intelligent Operation Center and Public Works to enhance public safety; and


WHEREAS, other areas of focus will include Arts, Cyber Security, Green Stability, Healthcare, and Technology; and


WHEREAS, the City Council also desires to implement a Green Sustainable Community limiting the City’s impact on the environment by managing storm water and implementing green building codes.






